From Geneva to Lyon

From Nîmes to Marseille

- We'll head to typical provence villages, St Rémy de Provence, Les Baux de Provenances, for lunch
- We'll take a side trip to Rousillon, Gordes in Luberon to walk along the Sentier des Ocres, (powdery sunset coloured orches) don't wear white
- Arrive in Marseille around 6h30 pm
- Stay 3 nights in Marseille

2 free days in Marseille

- How about kayaking ? (extra) .. or hike with a guide to the Calanques (extra)

From Marseille to Fréjus
